
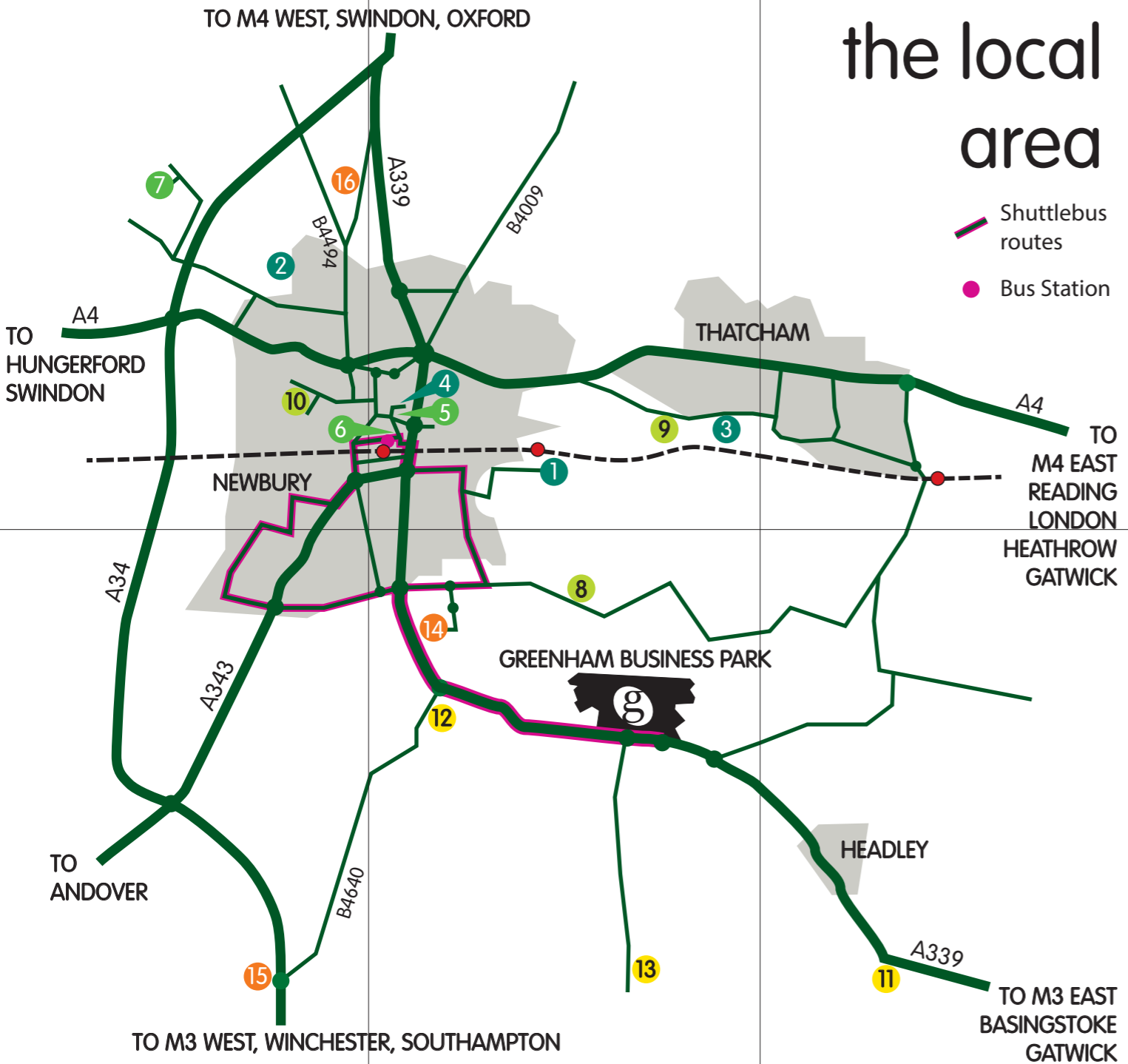

The War Memorial



A tri-part memorial for the US servicemen who died in two separate flying accidents at Greenham Common in 1944, and to all US servicemen who gave their lives for freedom.

A service is held at the Memorial every year on 12th December by the Newbury Branch of the Royal British Legion.
